2008-2009 SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION AND APPLICATION FORMS

A limited number of merit- and need-based scholarships for courses and private music instruction will be granted each year at the discretion of the Director of Hope Academy of Music and the Arts. Those applying for a need-based scholarship must provide documentation of financial need. Preference will be given to returning Hope Academy students in good standing, especially those participating in the work-study program as teaching assistants.

It is important that you follow the instructions closely, include signatures where indicated, and return the required forms by the deadline. **Incomplete applications and those received after the September 3rd deadline will not be considered.**

In order to be considered for a scholarship, both the student applicant *and* the parent/guardian must send a letter (the student letter must be HANDWRITTEN), detailing the following:

- Financial need for scholarship (if applying for a need-based scholarship documentation is required to verify financial need, see below*)
- Specific interest in the subject matter
- Ways in which the student will benefit from the course or private music instruction

*The following documents may be submitted to verify financial need. Only one document is required:

- Eligibility for government sponsored School Lunch Program
- Fee Waiver for SAT test
- Eligibility for Supplemental Security Income (SSI)
- Eligibility for Section 8 Housing

CHECKLIST FOR SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATIONS

- Course Scholarship Application Form and/or Discover the Talent Scholarship Application Form (one is for courses at Hope Academy, the second is for private music instruction).
- Student applicant letter (must be handwritten and signed by both the student and parent/guardian)
- Parent/guardian letter (signed by the parent)
- Documentation to verify financial need, if applying for need-based assistance
